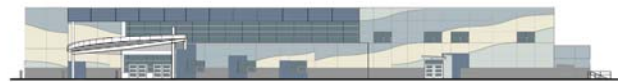

Instruction will take place on-site as well as in the community through work experiences such as internships and apprenticeships. The Mat-Su Career and Technical High School will eventually offer distance learning programs, so that those in remote areas have access.

## **Full-Time Student Application Process for 2010-2011**

**Students seeking full-time admission to the Mat-Su Career and Technical High School must:**

- 1. Complete and submit the attached application. Deadline is April 2, 2010**
  - 2. Student must write a one-page essay explaining why they desire admission to the Mat-Su Career and Technical High School including the skills, abilities, and/or attitudes they have to offer. Also, they should provide any additional information which may be helpful in the selection process.**
  - 3. Participate in an interview with their parents or guardian conducted by the Mat-Su Career and Technical High School administrator.**
  - 4. All applicants must attain a score at or above the school's designated range on a math placement test.**
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- Admission will be based on a first come first serve basis with emphasis on proportionate numbers from attendance areas in our district and various pathways.**
  - Students with special needs will be included into the career pathways with analysis of their Individual Education Plan (IEP) and consideration of their individual abilities and personal safety.**
  - Discipline, attendance and academic records will be reviewed to assure appropriate placement.**
  - Students denied admission may access an appeal process.**
  - Some national certifications require a four year sequence of courses.**
  - Applications can be faxed to 907-352-0480 or mailed to Mat-Su Career and Technical High School (see address on front page).**
  - All applications will be dated and time stamped in the order that they are received.**
  - If you applied last year and had elected to be placed on the wait list, last years application is the affective date for any vacancies in grades 10, 11, & 12. Parents/Students will be notified of any vacancies and an interview appointment will be scheduled.**
  - Applicants will be contacted as soon as possible to schedule an interview with the administrator.**

# **The Mat-Su Career and Technical High School**

## **Frequently Asked Questions**

### ***1. I want to go to college – is the Career and Technical High School for me?***

Yes! The courses available at the Career and Technical High School will be rigorous and provide focus to help students choose an area of study BEFORE they enter any type of post-secondary education whether it is trade school, two-year college, or four-year university.

### ***2. Will there be transportation to the Career and Technical High School?***

Bus transportation for students coming to the Career and Technical High School will be provided through several different methods. The largest number of students will ride their neighborhood school bus to their home base school and then take a shuttle to the Career and Technical High School. (Schools: Palmer High, Valley Pathways, Colony High, Burchell, Mid-Valley, Wasilla High, Houston High). At the end of the school day a shuttle will return in time to catch the regular route from the home base school. Students who are enrolled in satellite majors or half-time Career and Technical High School students will utilize the before and after school shuttle as well as a mid-day shuttle.

Students who cannot utilize the transportation provided must provide their own transportation.

### ***3. Will students with special needs be able to attend the Career and Technical High School?***

Students with special needs will be included into the programs with consideration of their individual abilities and analysis of their IEP. The placement of students will emphasize their ability to be successful and their individual safety. Support and help will be provided as necessary, based on their IEP.

### ***4. What kind of activities will be available for me at the Career and Technical High School?***

Full-time students attending the Career and Technical High School will have the opportunity to participate in the kinds of extracurricular activities the physical facility at the Career and Technical High School will allow, but will not include sports programs. Students will be allowed to participate in sports in their home boundary school.

The Career and Technical High School will provide the opportunity for the development of numerous clubs and organizations. Co-curricular Career and Technical Student Organizations taught with associated programs will be established, such as: SkillsUSA, Business Professionals of America (BPA), Health Occupation Students of America (HOSA), Family, Careers, and Community Leaders of America (FCCLA). Eligibility standards for participation in these activities will be the same as for activities throughout our school district.

***5. Will I go to the Career and Technical High School all day?***

The Career and Technical High School is a comprehensive high school and full-time students will be able to fulfill all requirements to earn a MSBSD High School diploma. Electives at the Center will consist of classes from the chosen career pathway major. There are several career majors who will remain in their current locations: Welding Technology, Outdoor Power Equipment, Automotive Technology, and Agriculture and Natural Resources. Students enrolled in these majors may choose to attend the Career and Technical High School for their academic classes and will be considered full-time Career and Technical High School students.

***6. Will all districtwide pathway classes be at the Career and Technical High School?***

No, certain programs will remain at their current locations and become satellite programs for the Career and Technical High School. These are programs which have facilities that have been certified by industry; Welding Technology, Outdoor Power Equipment, Automotive Technology, and Agriculture and Natural Resources.

***7. Will I be able to get a MSBSD High School Diploma and other Certifications at the Career and Technical High School?***

Yes, the Career and Technical High School is a comprehensive high school and full-time students will be able to fulfill all requirements to earn a MSBSD High School diploma. In addition, several pathway majors prepare students to take industry tests which lead to certifications. For example, the Certified Nursing Assistant major prepares students for the Alaska Certified Nursing Assistant certification.

***8. Will it cost me anything to go to the Career and Technical High School?***

The fees and expenses involved in attending the Career and Technical High School are the same as those associated with other MSBSD high schools. Each career pathway will have clothing requirements. There will be additional costs to students who choose to take industry certification tests.

***9. Can I change my pathway and major once I start at the Career and Technical High School?***

Yes, it is possible to change your major within a pathway or to change to a different pathway. Depending on when the change occurs, it might be difficult to complete the sequence of courses within the major and earn certification.

***10. Do I have to have a job in order to attend the Career and Technical High School?***

No, however relevant work experience is an integral part of the Career and Technical High School curriculum.
