



Hello, MDS Families:

In the event that we need to use remote learning, middle school and high school students will follow the schedule below:

Sessions are 25 minutes long, and students will have a 5 minute break between each class to stretch and prepare for the next class. Students will also have a 30 minute lunch break between Periods 3 and 4.

About Sessions:

- Attendance IS being taken on remote learning days!
- Students are still earning points for their attendance and behavior during sessions.
- Failure to attend will affect the timeline of their exit from the program.
- If your family does not have reliable internet, this needs to be communicated to your child's case manager by a parent or guardian.

About Classwork:

- Teachers will be available for "office hours" from 1:30-3:00 in their respective Zoom sessions if students need additional help with assignments.
- Parents are encouraged to check StudentVue/ParentVue for missing work and look at assignments in their child's Google Classroom to help with accountability.

About Communication:

1. The main mode for student communication is Gmail
2. The main mode for parent/guardian communication is the district email (Outlook)
3. Administration will send information about the closure and give an overview of what can be expected
4. The district will also be sending emails to families regarding the closure
5. Our remote plan will be posted on the MDS district website
6. Teachers will be available from 1:30-3:00 for lesson support & conferencing for all students/families. This is a time that any student, or family, will be able to connect with a teacher if they are struggling or need more clarification on lessons.

Student Expectations:

- Being on-time to the session
- Be prepared to engage in lesson
- Have your lights on in the Zoom room
- Be fully dressed without hats and hoods
- Video should be on so the teacher can see your face
- In the event of disrespect towards the teacher or classmates, students will be removed from the class
