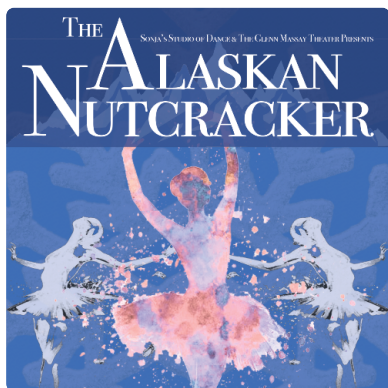

Morning Drop-Off Safety Requirements!

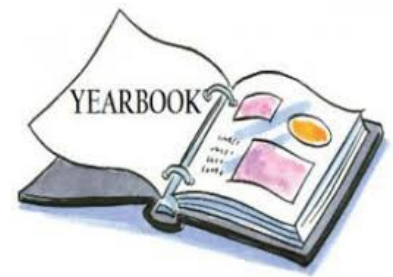
- PLEASE RESPECT ALL DIRECTIONS GIVEN BY OUR MORNING TRAFFIC VOLUNTEER

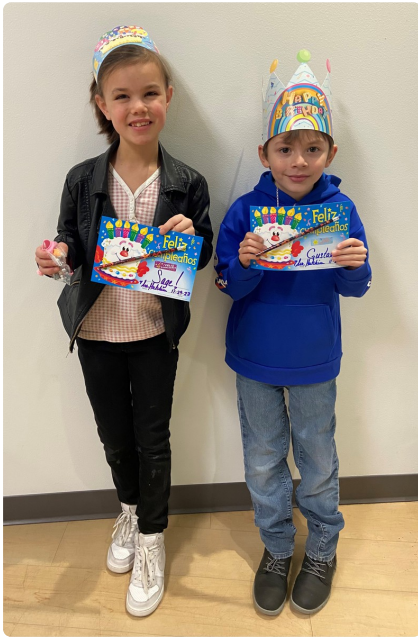
