IS THIS YOU?

Your family depends on subsistence activities to feed your family, and....

*Has your child, in the past 3 years participated in **fishing or berry picking** and brought the food home? (Dates must fall within a one year period.)*

AND were the activities at least **20 miles away** from your primary residence **7 overnights or more?** (Does not need to be consecutive)

OR did your children travel with you while you were **logging, and/or farming,** outside of the Mat-Su Borough School District?

If the answer is **yes**, your children may qualify for Migrant Education Services. All activities must meet economic necessity and program qualifications for program enrollment.
