2. Introductions: Johnston/Lincoln/Link/Looney/McMahon
3. General Rules and Policies (MSBSD):
 1. Student must be signed up on PlanetHS.com
 2. A current physical through the end of the season must be on file in order to practice.
 3. Insurance is mandatory and may be purchased if needed.
 1. Any practice completed with one of the above missing will not count toward the mandatory 10 practices.
 4. Students must pay a \$200 Activity Fee- Waived this year!
4. Eligibility: Quarter 1 Checks
 1. Underclassmen: must be enrolled in a minimum of 5 classes and have passed at least 5 classes the previous semester with a minimum of a 2.0. (exception: entering fall freshmen).
 2. Seniors: must be enrolled in a minimum of 4 classes and have passed at least 4 classes the previous semester with a minimum of a 2.0.
5. Practice Requirements:
 1. Every participant must have 10 practices before he/she can compete.
 2. You must be in school a 1/2 day in order to attend practice.
6. Game Requirements/Information:
 1. Students must be in all scheduled classes for the day.
 2. If you are traveling, you must be in class the day before your trip (unless you leave after school hours).
 3. There will be a bus to all out of district events (not always a return).
7. Sick/Appointments/Trouble getting to school:
 1. If you wake up sick on Game Day, then you must have a Dr. Note saying you are ok to still participate in the game. Or come to school and have the nurse send you home to rest.
 2. Scheduled appointments must be pre-approved by Mrs. Johnston.
 3. If you are having car trouble, go in the ditch, don't have a ride to school, call 861-5515 immediately so that Mrs. Johnston can help you create a plan.
8. Transportation:
 1. Parents are expected to drop off and pick up students on time for each practice.
 2. Busses will be provided to all out of district games.
 3. Parents may drive their own child to and from games/events (coaches' discretion).
 4. Students may ride with another adult (over 21) but it must be approved with a written note submitted to Mrs. Johnston before traveling (email does not count).
8. Behavior:
 1. Electronic, verbal, and/or physical hazing and harassment= Zero tolerance policy at CHS.
 1. Tell your coach, Mrs. Johnston, Mr. Lincoln or Mr. McMahon right away!

2. If you are ejected from a game, you will have to set out the next game. If you are involved in a fight during a game, there will also be school sanctions.
3. Inappropriate use of social media will not be tolerated and could lead to dismissal.
 1. Forwarding videos and/or pictures is a crime.
 2. No pictures are to be taken in lockers rooms or areas where athletes are changing.
9. TAD Policy (Tobacco, Alcohol and Drugs): See ASAA.org for more information.
 1. This document is strictly enforced from the time it is signed until the student graduates. This will also follow the student to any school in the state.
 2. Proximity Rule: if you are at a party, friend's house, etc. and there is tobacco, alcohol and/or drugs being used, you need to get out. If you hang around, we will not be trying to find out if you are using because you are guilty by being around it.
 3. Tobacco includes smokeless, e-cigarettes, and vaping.
10. Miscellaneous Information:
 1. Coaches will establish lettering criteria; the Activities Dept. requires that you end the season in good standing.
11. Facility Use:
 1. No parking behind the school (disability only).
 2. Players and parents will need to park outside of the gates (please do not block gates).
 3. We ask that everyone does their part to keep our school clean. Clean up after yourselves in the locker rooms, on the fields, in the gyms, hallways, classrooms, and commons.
12. Injuries/Concussions:
 1. All injuries MUST be reported to the coaches (even if it does not happen during the sport).
 2. Coaches are required to fill out a Student Injury Report Form, turn it into the school nurse and to Mrs. Johnston. So it is very important that they are notified immediately of all injuries.
 3. Athletes who have any sign of a concussion will have to set out the remainder of the event/game.
 4. Concussion Protocol starts with any sign of a concussion.
13. Concussion Video (Football, Wrestling and Hockey only)- on the Athletics Website
14. COVID Info-
 1. Masks are required for staff, students, and spectators. Athletes do not need to wear masks when engaging in physical activity.
 1. We will have limited spectators...this number will be decided on by the district in the near future based on the size of each venue. All events will be free for spectators.
 2. All spectators will be asked to social distance 6ft. from others in all sitting and standing areas. Administration will be monitoring the spacing and will ask for more spacing if needed.
