



## MAT-SU BRANCH – AMERICAN SOCIETY OF CIVIL ENGINEERS (ASCE) SCHOLARSHIPS FOR 2023 HIGH SCHOOL SENIORS AND UNDERGRADUATE COLLEGE STUDENTS

The Mat-Su American Society of Civil Engineers (ASCE) is offering one (1) \$1,000 scholarship to a 2023 senior graduating from high school in the Mat-Su Borough School District or a Mat-Su Borough School District high school alumni currently enrolled in, or planning to enroll in, an undergraduate college engineering degree program. Public school, religious school, other private school, and home school seniors are eligible to apply. Mat-Su Borough residency is an eligibility requirement for these scholarships.

### Application Requirements:

Write a 500-word essay addressing the following items (in no particular order) **(30 points)**:

- What field of engineering are you interested in? Explain why.
- Explain why you think engineering would be a good career for you.
- Describe a notable engineer or engineering project that has made an impact on the field of engineering that interests you. How does it inspire you?

Provide a complete, official transcript showing your high school and college (if applicable) courses and grades. **(25 points)**

Provide a resume that describes your education, extracurricular activities, community service activities, and work experience. List extracurricular letters, certificates, and/or awards earned, time spent on each community service activity, and approximate total employment hours for each job held. Hours per day (or week) and dates that jobs were held is sufficient. **(25 points)**

Provide three letters of recommendation. These letters should be from teachers, coaches, band leaders, other extracurricular or community service activity supervisors, and/or employers. At least one letter must be from a math and/or science teacher. Letters are not required to be sealed. **(15 points)**

A complete application package will include a scholarship application form (attached), essay, official transcript, resume, and three letters of recommendation. Applications should be neat and well-organized. **(5 points)**

### Engineering Major Requirement

To receive ASCE Mat-Su Branch engineering scholarships, applicants must be enrolled in the Fall 2023 or Spring 2024 as declared engineering majors. Proof of enrollment will be required prior to transfer of awarded funds.

Scholarship applications are due on or before **April 17, 2023**.
