For language arts, math, science and social studies, specific course requirements may be fulfilled by substituting a higher level of the same course (e.g. Honors Biology). For math and science, specific course requirements may also be fulfilled by substituting a course for which the required course is the prerequisite.

MSBSD will continue to work with students transferring into MSBSD from other Districts, students transferring within Mat-Su, and students with Individual Education Plans (IEPs). In some cases, modifications and accommodations to the graduation requirements will be made to ensure all students are successful.
