We wanted to give you a heads up that your students' 2018-19 data in MobyMax will be archived on August 1st. After data is archived, you can still access your students' prior progress history, placement test results, lesson scores, and session times. Students' game time and badges also stick around.

This year, our curriculum has been revised to be based on specific state standards! **This means that how students start off the school year will be different from last year.**

Here's how this will work for particular subjects and modules:

- All students will start with a new placement test in Math, Language, and Foundational Reading.
- Students will start with the first lesson of their grade level in Reading Skills Literature, Reading Skills Info, and Test Prep.
- In all other subjects, students will start where they left off last year unless you restart them in a particular subject.
- All Benchmarker tests and data will be deleted.

If you'd like to keep specific records like Benchmarker results or contest leaderboards, now is the time to save them as PDFs or print them out.

We suggest that you avoid giving your students a placement test or having them work in Moby during those last few days of July so they aren't "interrupted" by the archiving on August 1st!
