



Migrant Education Do you qualify?

IS THIS YOU?

Your family depends on subsistence activities to feed your family, and.....

Your child(ren) has, in the past 3 years, participated in fishing, commercial fishing and/or berry picking and brought the food home (dates must fall within a one year period);

AND the activities were at least 20 miles away from your primary residence for 7 overnights or more (does not need to be consecutive);

OR your child(ren) traveled with you while you were **logging and/or farming** outside of the Mat-Su Borough School District for 7 overnights or more (does not need to be consecutive).

If the answer is **yes**, your children may qualify for Migrant Education Services. All activities must meet economic necessity for program qualification.
