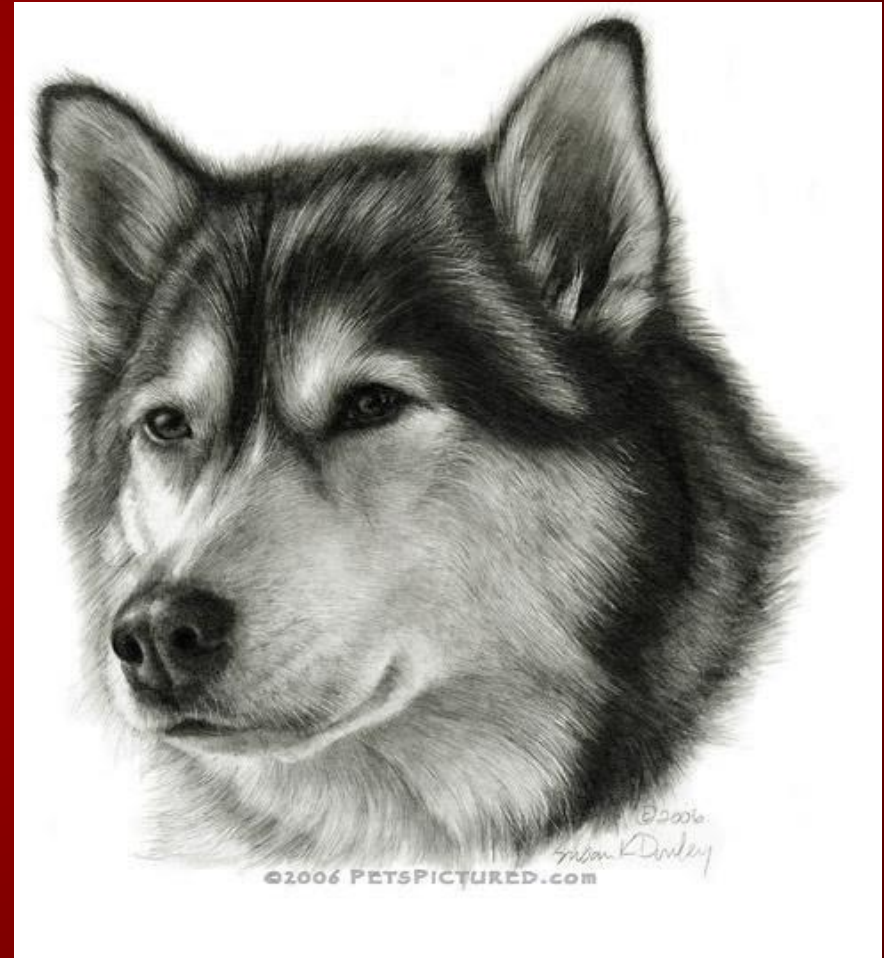

- We'll have Title I and other information in our newsletters and on our website.



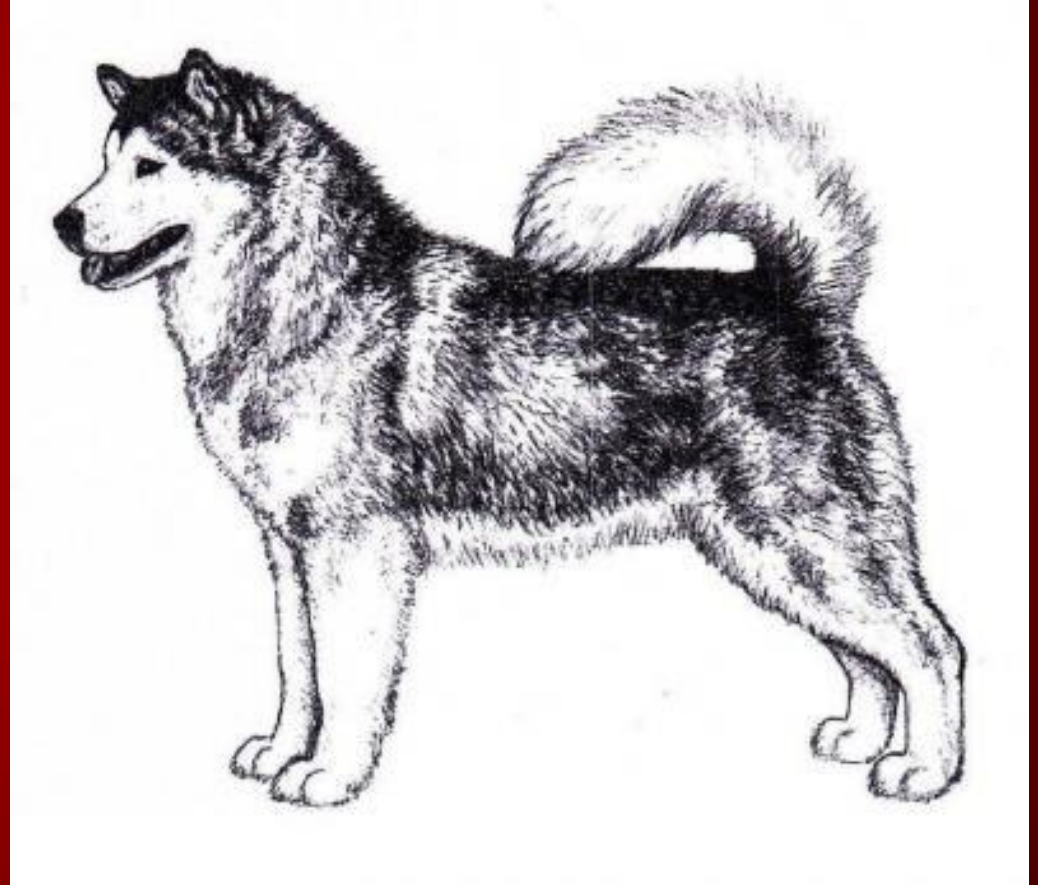
# EVERYONE IS INVITED TO OUR TITLE I FAMILY EVENTS AND MEETINGS!

# FAMILY INVOLVEMENT = SCHOOL SUCCESS

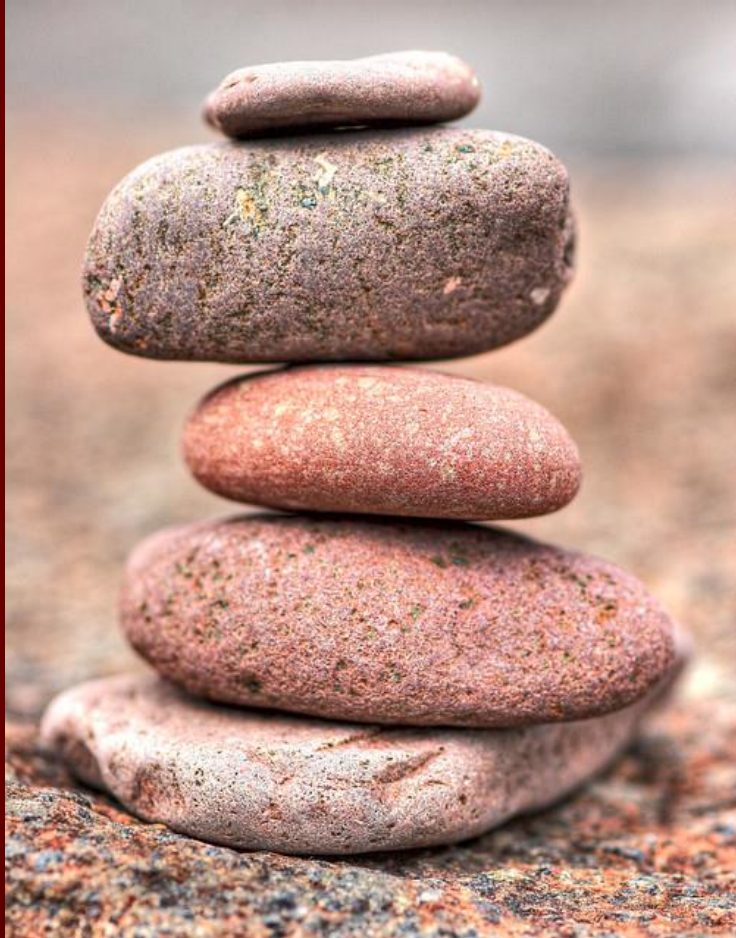
When our families are involved in our schools, student success can be seen in many ways!

**The left eye and the right eye create one focal point.**

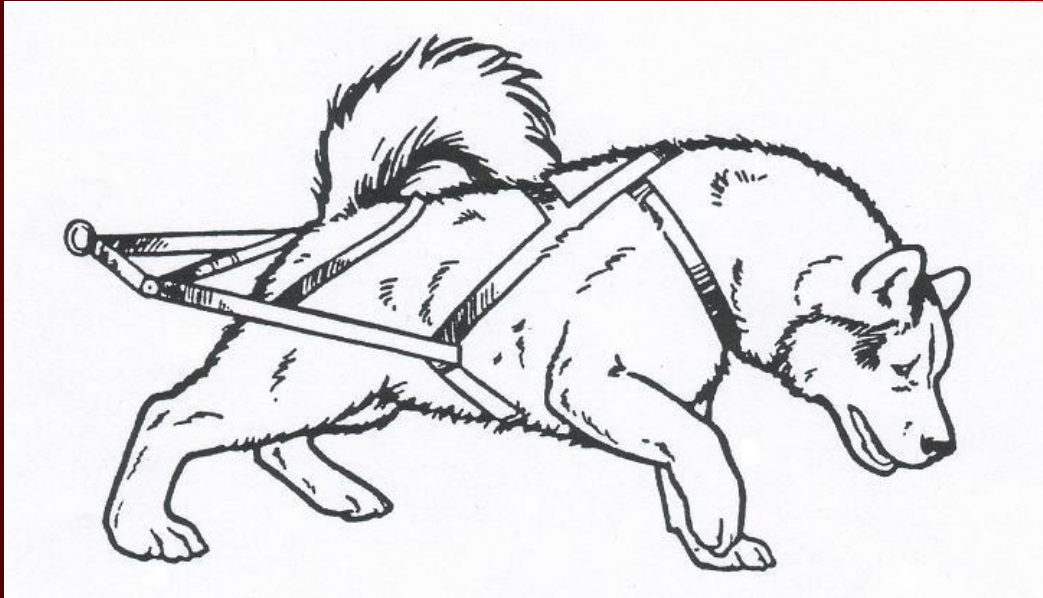
- Trauma informed practice creates a context where social emotional needs do not become discipline issues.
