Student Ambassador Description

The Student Ambassador Program at Fronteras, sponsored by the APC Board, will recognize up to two students annually to represent Fronteras within the school and local community. Students interested in applying for this position should be self motivated and passionate about their immersion experience, with a desire to model good citizenship. Students will have the opportunity to grow their skills in leadership, public speaking, and communication. Students will be expected to attend multiple speaking events (see list below) throughout the year, speaking in both Spanish and English. Students will also be expected to complete 10 hours of community service in an area of their choosing. Finally, Students will be awarded a \$300 scholarship to be applied to the Puerto Rico Immersion Experience at the conclusion of their 8th grade year.

Minimum Requirements for Applying

- Open to students entering 6th, 7th or 8th grades
- At least 2 years attending Fronteras
- Minimum GPA 2.0
- Good disciplinary standing
- Completed Application with Parent/guardian signature
- Two Letters of Recommendation
 - *1 letter must be from outside Fronteras staff*
 - *Family member letters are not allowed*
- Formal Interview with 3 person selection committee-will include questions in English and Spanish

Program Expectations

- Student(s) may be asked to speak at the following proposed events: Fronteras Open House, Fronteras Middle School Orientation, one Quarter Fronteras Assembly, one MSBSD School Board Assembly meeting, one Rotary Club, two APC Board meetings annually, Fronteras Lottery Night, MSBSD Kindergarten Night;
- Student(s) may be asked to assist in conducting school tours annually;
- 10 hours of community service;
- Written final reflection paper presented orally to the APC Board
