

BIG LAKE LIONS 2020 SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION RULES & RESPONSIBILITIES



APPLICATION DEADLINE

All applications must be received or post marked by April 1, 2020.

SCHOLARSHIP DETAILS

1. Scholarships shall be awarded annually to students selected by the Scholarship Committee. The amount of the yearly scholarship shall be determined annually by the Big Lake Lions Board of Directors.
2. A recipient is limited to one award per year and may apply for additional scholarships in ensuing years for continued education up to 3 years.

SELECTION CRITERIA

1. The recipient must have graduated from high school or the equivalent thereof.
The maximum age for an applicant is 21.
2. The applicant will provide a personal history; typed (double spaced) and at least one but no more than two pages in length. Make this a special comment illustrating what is unique about yourself, your family and your personal and professional goals.
3. The applicant will provide two letters of recommendation. Letters may be from teachers, persons for whom you have worked, and one may be a personal reference.
4. It is the responsibility of the applicant to request an official transcript documenting scholastic records showing a minimum or a 2.75 GPA. Have it mailed to the Big Lake Lions Club.
5. Essay question: The benefits of belonging to a community service organization.

SCHOLARSHIP FUNDS

The Big Lake Lions shall issue a written notice of award or phone call to successful applicants.

Before the award can be dispersed, your college student ID number must be submitted to the Big Lake Lions Scholarship Committee, attn: Chairperson, and can be included in the application with your phone number to the included address.

All funds will be paid directly to the Registrars Office.

In the event the recipient does not become enrolled, or withdraws during the first semester, the full amount of the scholarship shall be refunded to the Big Lake Lions.

REQUIREMENTS CHECKLIST REMINDERS

1. Incomplete or late applications will not be considered. All paperwork must be

post marked by April 1, 2020.

2. Personal history must be one to two pages, double spaced and typed.
3. Must include two letters of recommendations.
4. Must include letter from parent or guardian explaining financial need.
5. Official transcript to be mailed to Big Lake Lions showing a 2.75 GPA.
6. Cover sheet filled out
7. 2020 SCHOLARSHIP ESSAY. The essay is required: it must be between one and two page's and address the following question. The benefits of being involved in a community service organization.
