SCHOLARSHIP PROCEDURE

1. Submit a letter of request for scholarship assistance stating career goals and reasons for your career choice.
2. Submit a letter giving a brief summary about yourself, your history and involvement with Alaska's hospitality industry (if applicable) and community activities.
3. Tell us why we should award the scholarship to you above all other applicants.
4. Provide proof of admittance to an accredited university or post-secondary vocational school.
5. A headshot or "action" picture of yourself in high-resolution .jpg format (you can submit on disk or email to info@alaskacharr.com). Photo may be used in promotional materials of the scholarship and Ed Fund programs.
6. Complete the application form, and return to: 1503 W. 31st Ave. Suite 202, Anchorage, AK 99503 by the **May 15th deadline**. Be sure to include steps 1 - 6 above

DECISION-MAKING PROCESS/TIMELINE:

- Applications due May 15th of each year
- Committee makes decisions by end of June
 - Notifications mailed in July
- Checks mailed to school by end of August
