MSMCS Course Descriptions:

Adv Lit Seminar:	Required for first time WRTG 111, academic probation, or by choice. Stack with Adv Soc Seminar; meets M/W or T/R
Adv Math Seminar:	Required for first time MATH 105, academic probation, or by choice. Stack with Adv Sci Seminar; meets M/W or T/R
Adv Soc Seminar:	May be taken by choice or required by academic probation. Stack with Adv Lit Seminar; meets M/W or T/R
Adv Sci Seminar:	May be taken by choice or required by academic probation. Stack with Adv Math Seminar; meets M/W or T/R
Adv Comp:	1st high school English class in our series for students who don't test in to WRTG 111; meets 3 x week
Clg Comp:	3rd high school English class in our series for students who have completed Adv Comp and Humanities; meets 3 x week
HS Math ALEKS<15	High school math class for students who score less than 15 on ALEKS retest; meets 3 x week
HS Math ALEKS >15	High school math class for students who have not tested into MATH 105; above ALEKS 15; meets 3 x week
Office Hours	Open for tutoring

General Scheduling Guidelines:

MSMCS students must be enrolled in a minimum of 4 classes through the Middle College/MSC, which must include a minimum of 6 college credits per semester. Course shares at another school do not count toward this minimum.

Ms. Piatt will automatically add high school math or English and seminars to student schedules beginning the first week of August.

College schedules are visible in student UAOnline accounts after college advising and course registration. Complete high school and college schedules will be viewable in StudentVUE/ParentVUE the second week of August.
