If we go to High Risk: Full building closure. All students and staff will be on at-home learning/teaching.

Topic	Green (Low Risk) and Yellow (Medium Risk) Protocols
Prior to Coming to School	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Please take your child’s temperature. Students with 100+ temperatures should stay home until 24 hours without a fever ● Symptom screen your child. If he/she has any symptoms, please stay home until 24 hours without symptoms <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Fever or chills ○ Cough ○ Difficulty breathing or shortness of breath ○ Sore throat, congestion, or runny nose ○ Nausea, vomiting, or diarrhea ○ Headache ○ Fatigue ○ Muscle, joint or body aches ○ New loss of taste or smell ● Please follow all state mandated quarantine requirements if you have traveled out-of-state
Arrival	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Drop-off students will enter through the gymnasium doors beginning at 9:00am ● Yellow dots are on sides walks to facilitate social distancing ● Parents will not be allowed to walk students to the classroom
Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) *District mask guidelines - updated 8/10/2020	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Masks are required for all students Grades 3 - 5 ● Masks are recommended for Grades K – 2, but not required ● A face shield with cloth or surgical mask fabric neck guard will meet the requirement of a mask ● Teachers will be providing frequent mask breaks throughout the school day <p>*Hand sanitizer, hand lotion, and youth mask donations are greatly appreciated!</p>
Classroom Setup	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Social distancing to the maximum extent possible ● Students will stay with teachers for literacy, math, science, and social studies ● Assigned classroom seats <p>*Plexiglass partitions (sneeze guards) donations are greatly appreciated!</p>
Supplies	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Students will bring their own supplies to be kept in their backpack, personal cubby, or desk <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Supplies will be provided by the school as needed ● Sharing of food and drink is prohibited ● Personal water bottles are encouraged; drinking fountains are turned off ● When necessary, limit the use of shared supplies or equipment by one group of children at a time to allow for cleaning and disinfecting between uses

Bathrooms	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Scheduled bathroom breaks ● Outside scheduled bathroom breaks teachers will only allow one boy and one girl to the maximum extent possible ● Students will practice social distancing and be trained to properly wash their hands
Cleaning/ Handwashing	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Teachers will sanitize student workspace after lunch ● Teachers, staff, and students will be expected to clean hands upon entrance to school, before lunch, recess, and specials, and when returning to their classroom ● Teachers and staff will sanitize touch surfaces (doorknobs/light switches/desks, etc.) at the end of the day ● Custodial staff will disinfect each classroom daily
Specials	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Specials will rotate on a weekly basis ● Music will be in the portable for the majority of the year to allow for increased ventilation and social distancing ● PE will occur outside, weather permitting ● Library books will be held for 72 hours prior to restocking ● Yellow Protocol: Specials teachers will push into the classroom to the maximum extent possible
Lunch	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Breakfast and lunch will be delivered to classrooms ● Students will wash hands before and after lunch ● Teachers and staff are encouraged to disinfect student workspace after lunch ● Microwaves and refrigerators will not be available for students ● Shared birthday treats (cupcakes, cookies, etc.) are no longer permitted
Recess	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Monitors will sanitize touch surfaces at least 10 minutes prior to the first recess and after the last recess ● Normal recess procedure, monitors in allowed student areas ● Students will be permitted to take their masks off during outdoor recess ● Yellow Protocols: Students will play with classroom cohort in designated zones to the maximum extent possible
Dismissal	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Staggered dismissal times will be implemented to allow for proper social distancing starting with Grade 5 at 3:40pm ● All students will exit the doors closest to the bus loop <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Teachers will walk parent pick-up students to the front of the building ● Parents wanting to park and pick-up their students will wait in the designated parent area in the front of the building
