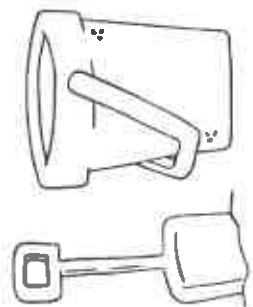


When working on blending activities, make sure you pause after each syllable and sound. A dash "-" is used to help remind you.
