Each pathway is a broad collection of classes that prepare students for a career, specifically a sequence of CTE courses that lead to an industry certification. Many CTE courses offer industry recognized certifications and college credit.

Pathways

Business & Information Technology (IT)

Classes help students prepare for a variety of careers in business and computer related fields. Students can earn college credit for many of the Business & IT courses, participate in State and National BPA competitions and earn industry recognized certifications.



Construction/Carpentry

Classes help students prepare for a variety of careers in the construction industry. Students can participate in State and National Skills USA competitions and earn industry recognized certifications.



Technical & Architectural Drafting

Classes help students prepare for careers in technical drafting and architecture design. Students can participate in State and National Skills USA competitions, and industry recognized certifications.



Tourism and Hospitality

Classes help students prepare for careers in the hospitality and tourism industry. This is a high-demand industry in the state of Alaska with many career opportunities.



Welding (9-12)

Classes help students prepare for a variety of careers in welding. Students can participate in State and National Skills USA competitions and earn industry recognized certifications.
