Automotive

Classes help students prepare for careers in the automotive industry, and small engine repair. Students can participate in State and National Skills USA competitions, earn NATEF certifications, and earn college credit.



Business & Information Technology (IT)

Classes help students prepare for a variety of careers in business and computer related fields. Students can earn college credit for many of the Business & IT courses, participate in State and National BPA competitions and earn industry recognized certifications.



Construction/Carpentry

Classes help students prepare for a variety of careers in the construction industry. Students can participate in State and National Skills USA competitions and earn industry recognized certifications.



Technical & Architectural Drafting

Classes help students prepare for careers in drafting and architecture design. Students can participate in State and National Skills USA competitions, earn college credit and industry recognized certifications.
