Have you registered to vote or know how to when you turn 18?

Have you registered for the selective service?

Who is your primary care Doctor? Provide their address and phone number

What is your medical insurance and copay? If you don't have medical insurance once you graduate, what will you do to make sure you are insured?

Who is your dentist? Provide their address and phone number.

Are you on any medications? What pharmacy do you refill them at? What is the phone number?

If you worked last year, did you file your taxes this year? When is the tax deadline?

Do you know your social security number? Do you know where your SS card and Birth Certificate are at?

### Daily Living Skills:

What role do you play in keeping your clothes clean and ready for school? (sorting/doing your own laundry/ironing/putting them away, etc)

If there is something that you want to purchase, how do you go about getting it now? (do you have an allowance, can you earn money for chores, ask parents, etc)

When there is no longer a meal provided for at home, what would you do for breakfast, lunch and dinner?

What chores do you do around the house to help your family out?
